

GUIDELINES FOR SUNDAY FELLOWSHIP HOSTS

At the present time it is our custom that the Hosts donate the “edibles” or morning treats. We recommend that there be at least two persons hosting to spread the cost. It’s safe to plan on about 15 people to stay for coffee after the 1st Service and between 60 & 75 after the 2nd Service (more at special times like Christmas, Easter, and Children’s day for example). Food should be out on the tables about 9:30 a.m. for the 1st Service, and then removed right before the 2nd Service. Drinks may stay out all morning.

“Goodie” suggestions are cookies, coffee cakes, Danish pastries, cake, gingerbread, nut breads, donuts, donut holes, bagels and cream cheese, cut-up fruit, cheese and crackers. We also ask you to bring a qt. of 2% milk and a qt. of ½ and ½. These are placed in the two white carafes.

The morning treats are your choice, however please try to avoid “crumb” cakes or treats with colored jimmies or loose sprinkles (things that will fall and get ground into the carpet). At the end of the day there is probably nothing that doesn’t generate some crumbs, but we feel that this is a relatively small thing compared to all the joy and good fellowship the coffee hour brings to people. Our custodians will vacuum later on Sunday.

The hosts are asked to come early enough to set up their treats on platters or in napkin-lined baskets and put them on the serving table. We also need you to monitor the coffee hour. Our children and teens need to be reminded not to devour all the goodies before the adults can have something. Some children need assistance in pouring juice or getting hot drinks. We all need to keep an eye on them.

The Coffee Hour Coordinator (now Barbara Ewick) will prepare the coffee, hot water, and cold drinks each week, as well as decorate the tables.

We would also ask the hosts to clean up afterwards, including washing off and drying the plastic table covers. If you have any questions or suggestions, please call Barbara Ewick at 732-940-9274.
